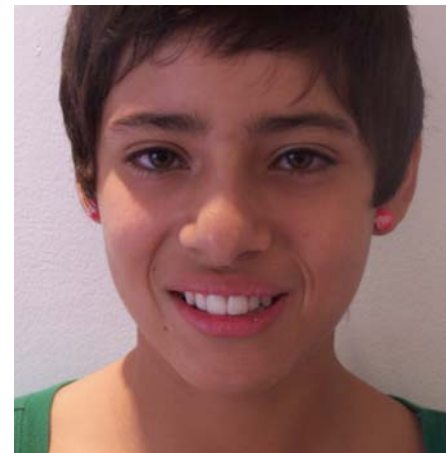
Dear Friends -

Here are the results of the Orthodontic treatment with Dr. Noriega, one of the Specialists who works with my patients in the Dental Department.

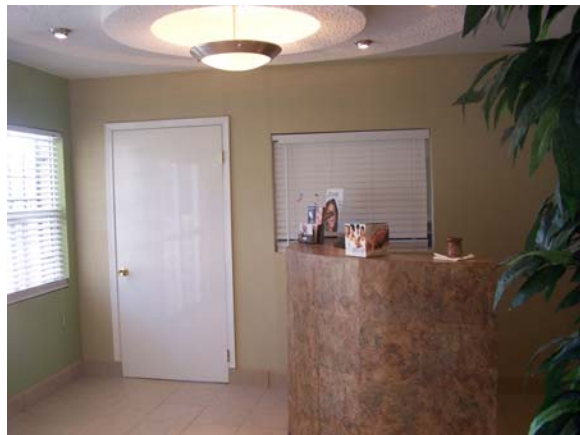

Before and After — Our Extensive Renovation

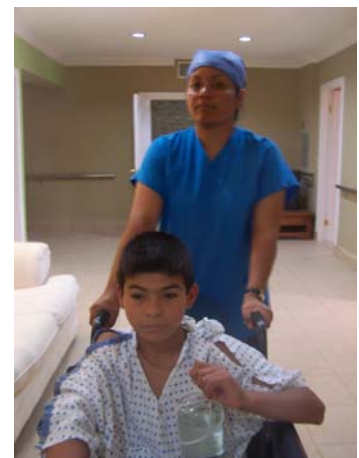




As our work on the clinic proceeded, Dr. Jurado and his colleagues provided care for our children at their clinic.
