Visitor Information

We are blessed in a great way each time a group comes to visit us. We not only benefit from the projects that they complete but from the fellowship they have with our children and our staff. The Lord is always at work when His people gather together. We thank you for your continued love and support. To follow is a list of suggested donations for staying at Emmanuel. It is not our intention to make money on these items but to ensure that our costs are covered so that we can continue to provide for the needs of the children and ministries in our care.

Lodging

Visitor Center for groups over 8 people. The **Suggested donation** to cover electricity, running water, and propane is **\$5 per person per day**.

Lopez House or other ministry house for small groups or families. The **Suggested donation** to offset additional electricity, running water and propane use is **\$5 per person per day**.

Food and Water

Visitor Center has a stand alone kitchen. Some groups choose to provide their own meals. You can do so using the kitchen facilities. Some groups choose to have us provide one or two meals a day and do their own thing for the other meals. You choose, we just need to know your desire so that we can make plans. The meal charges cover the cost of the food and the salaries of the food staff.

Meal Charges

Transportation

We do have vehicles with which we can pick groups up from the airport or the border to transport them to Emmanuel. We also occasionally take groups to the Mercado for a shopping visit. We ask for a donation for vehicle use based on number of vehicles and number of trips to cover our drivers and gasoline.

Donation amount differs based on usage.

Project

Most groups that come do building or maintenance projects and something special with the children. We provide some workers to work alongside you where needed but ask that you cover costs of all of the materials you need. We can help estimate the costs of projects as we work with you to determine what projects you want to do this visit.

Your Activities and Schedule

Each group is responsible for providing enough adult supervision to support your entire group. You choose your activities and your schedule with input from us. We let you know the schedule of our children so you can plan events with them at appropriate times. We provide possible projects, bilingual staff (not everyone but some) to act as support and to guide you when needed, and the hospitality to help make your trip a success.
