### Scholarships

All Isaac Newton Academy students receive partial to complete scholarships, making their quality education affordable. As compared to many other Christian schools, our operating costs for educating one student is minimal at only \$1,100 per year. All of our students are charged an annual tuition of \$200 and receive 80% to 100% tuition break depending on their individual situation. Approximately ten percent of the student population is from the Child Protective Services of Mexico (DIF) and receive a 100% FREE education.

### Our Needs

The cost for educating one child at Isaac Newton Academy is approximately \$1,100 per year. This includes the cost of the local teachers' salaries, curriculum, classroom supplies, office supplies, copies, certification expenses, building upkeep, bills, and expenses.

### Adopt a Class Program

Our goal is that each student in each classroom be adopted every year enabling us to continue providing an excellent education at an affordable rate. Through the "adoption" students will learn to more deeply value their education as they are in relationship with individuals who believe in their future. See our website for more information.

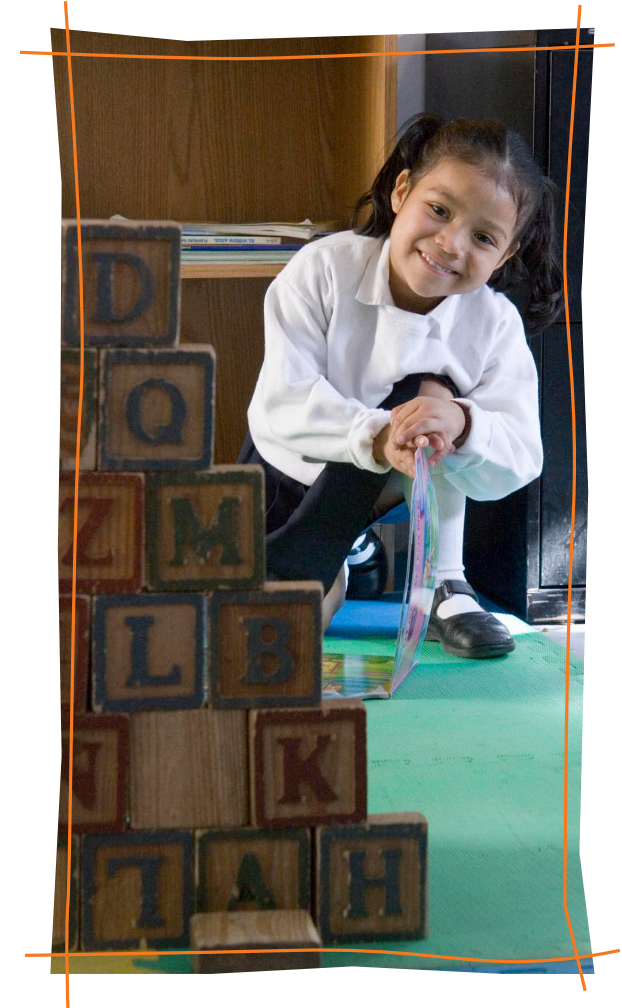

### *Education that Makes a Difference*

Isaac Newton Academy is located in the hills of Juarez, Mexico. There it serves as the only Christian school for the children of Emmanuel Children's Home and the surrounding neighborhood.

### *School Situation in Juarez*

The students of Emmanuel Children's Home would normally attend the public school. Unfortunately, the public school fails to meet the needs of these children. The children's true needs are often ignored by teachers, and they face constant discrimination because of their situation. The public school classrooms are overcrowded, often with 35 to 40 students with one teacher. Even after attempts to work with public schools, it was obvious that the children from the home were falling between the cracks and did not receive the educational opportunities they needed to succeed.



### *The Beginning*

In August 2003 the school started with 20 pre-school and kindergarten students. In August of 2004, first grade was added and in 2005 second grade. In August of 2006 we added grades three through six. Now all of our preschool and elementary age children receive a Christian education.

### *Our Philosophy*

The children of the Emmanuel Children's Home suffer many disadvantages because of their lack of healthy family circumstances. By working with them in a caring Christian school setting we believe that they can graduate elementary school with the skills needed to succeed in life. As these children do not receive much one-on-one time with a parent, the individual and small group instruction from loving teachers allows them to develop into confident and independent students who will influence the Kingdom of God.



### *Special Challenges*

Many of our children have learning and emotional disorders. However, we find that we are able to help them succeed by offering them individual and group instruction at their level; a necessity not possible through any other school system. We provide spiritual growth through weekly Bible lessons, character education, encouragement and loving discipline. We created a curriculum which covers all the main subjects, and is drawn from many resources. We also provide English lessons and computer classes starting in kindergarten.

### *Changing Lives*

These children, who once cried and begged not to go to school, now arrive each morning at Isaac Newton Academy excited to learn. Each child is encouraged to explore and use their God-given talents and abilities while being stretched and challenged to reach their full potential.
